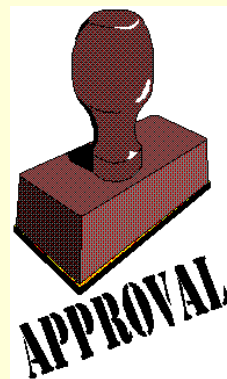

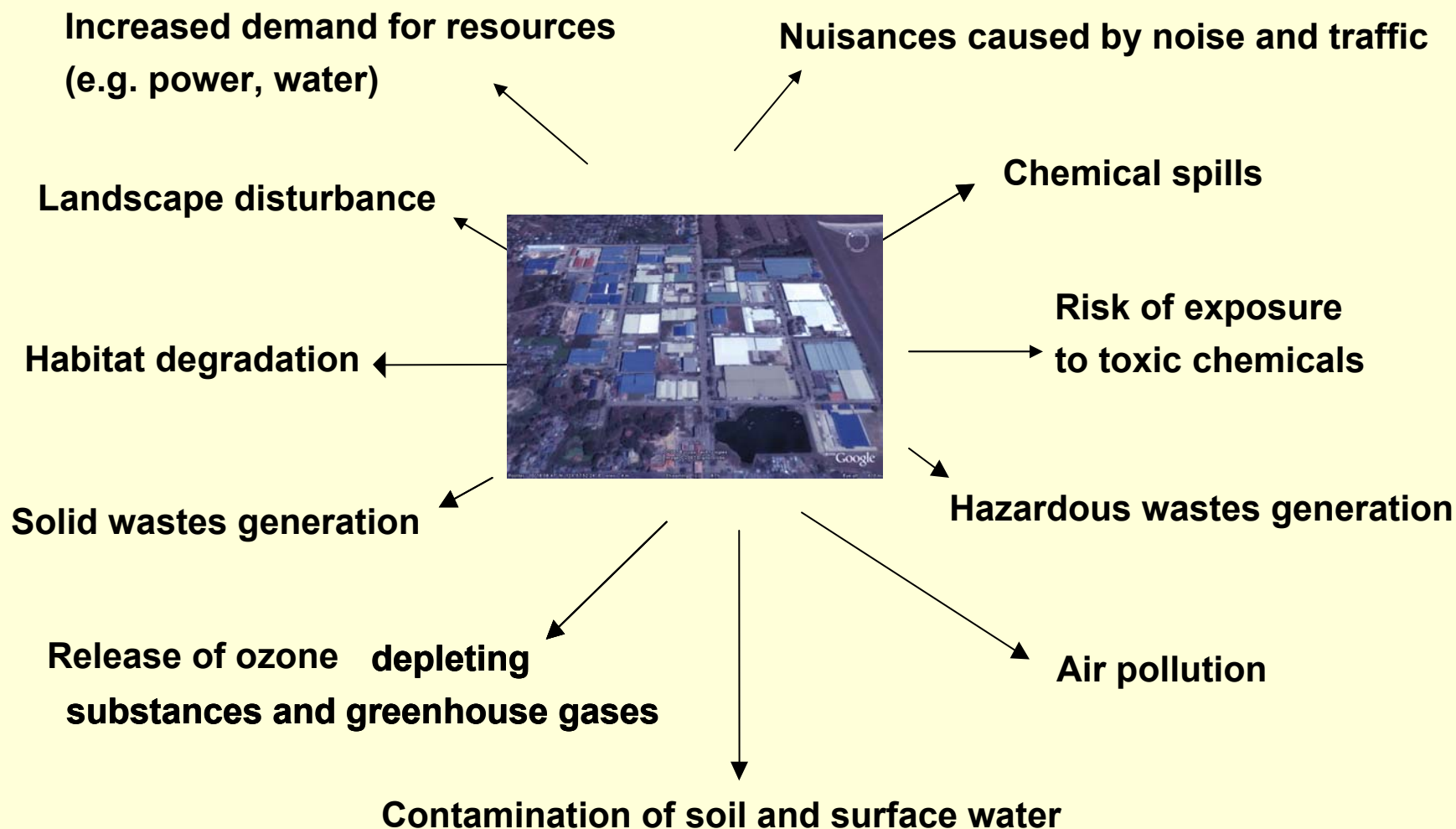

DENR-PEZA Memorandum of Agreement

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Agreement executed and entered into this 25th day of August, 1999 in Manila, Philippines by and between:

The **Department of Environment and Natural Resources**, created and duly organized pursuant to Executive Order No. 192, Series of 1987, with principal office address at Visayas Avenue, Quezon City, represented herein by its Secretary, **ANTONIO H. CERILLES**, hereinafter referred to as "**DENR**";

The **Philippine Economic Zone Authority**, created and duly organized pursuant to Republic Act No. 7916, with principal office address at Almada Bldg., Roxas Blvd. corner San Luis St., Pasay City, represented hereinafter referred to as "**PEZA**";

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, there is an expressed concern on the need for the streamlining of the current Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) System administrative set-up and permitting system with regard to the Environmental Compliance Certificate (ECC) applications of all environmentally critical projects as well as development permit applications involving the proclaimed economic zones;

WHEREAS, Presidential Decree No. 1151, otherwise known as the Philippine Environmental Policy "requires all agencies and instrumentalities of the National Government including Government Owned and Controlled Corporations (GOCCs) as well as private corporations, firms and entities to undertake an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) of their project activities or undertakings which may significantly affect the quality of the environment";

WHEREAS, DENR Administrative Order No. 37, Series of 1996, provides that: "(a) Environmentally Critical Projects shall be submitted to the Environmental Management Bureau (EMB); and (b) Projects that are not environmentally critical but within Environmentally Critical Areas shall be required an Initial Environment Examination to be submitted to the concerned DENR Regional office without prejudice to the submission of an EIS as may be further required by the Regional Executive Director;

WHEREAS, Section 33 of Republic Act No. 7916, otherwise known as the "The Special Economic Zone Act of 1995" as amended by Republic Act No. 8748 provides that "The PEZA in coordination with appropriate government agencies, shall take concrete and appropriate steps and enact proper measures for the protection of the local environment";

WHEREAS, Rule XXIV, Section 2, of Republic Act No. 7916 provides that as a matter of policy, PEZA shall enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the DENR, NWRB and other concerned government agencies for an integrated and

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Agreement (hereinafter referred to as "MOA") is executed this 12th day of December 2006 at Pasay City, Philippines, by and between:

PHILIPPINE ECONOMIC ZONE AUTHORITY, a government corporation created and operating under Republic Act No. 7916, as amended, otherwise known as "The Special Economic Zone Act of 1995," with principal office address at PEZA Building, Roxas Boulevard corner San Luis Street, Pasay City, represented herein by its Director General, **ATTY. LILIA B. DE LIMA**, who is duly authorized to represent it for this purpose, hereinafter referred to as "PEZA";

LAGUNA LAKE DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY, a government-owned and controlled corporation, created and operating under Republic Act No. 4850, as amended, with principal office address at 2nd and 3rd Floor Asia-Pro Building, 70 San Rafael St., Bo. Kapitolyo Pasig City, represented herein by its General Manager, **DR. CASIMIRO A. YNARES III**, who is likewise duly authorized to represent it for this purpose, hereinafter referred to as "LLDA";

WITNESSETH That:

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7916, as amended, mandates PEZA to set the general policies on the establishment and operations of the ECOZONES, industrial estates, export processing zones, free trade zones, and the like, and to regulate and undertake the establishment, operation and maintenance of utilities, other services and infrastructure in the ECOZONE, such as heat, light and power, water supply, telecommunication, transport, toll roads and bridges, port services, etc.;

WHEREAS, Section 33 of Republic Act No. 7916, as amended, provides that PEZA, in coordination with the appropriate agencies, shall take concrete and appropriate steps and enact the proper measure for the protection of the local environment;

WHEREAS, Section 4 (N) of Republic Act No. 4850, as amended, mandates the LLDA to act in coordination with existing government agencies in establishing water quality standards for industrial, agricultural and municipal waste discharges into the Laguna de Bay Region and to cooperate with said existing agencies of the government of the Philippines in enforcing such standards;

Subject : Guidelines on Handling and Transport of Economic Zones' Solid Wastes
Date : 17 January 2006

Effective 01 March 2006, PEZA shall implement the attached Guidelines on Handling and Transport of Economic Zones' Solid Wastes.

The Guidelines are based on Republic Act No. 8003 "Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000" and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (DENR Administrative Order No. 34 series of 2001), and formulated in consultation with DENR-National Solid Waste Management Commission.

Some major changes from the existing system are the accreditation of solid waste haulers and collectors, the imposition of fines and/or administrative sanctions, submission of a Solid Waste Management Plan (SWMP) by solid waste generators, and the use of Gate Pass to document transport of residual waste generated by economic zone locator enterprises for disposal.

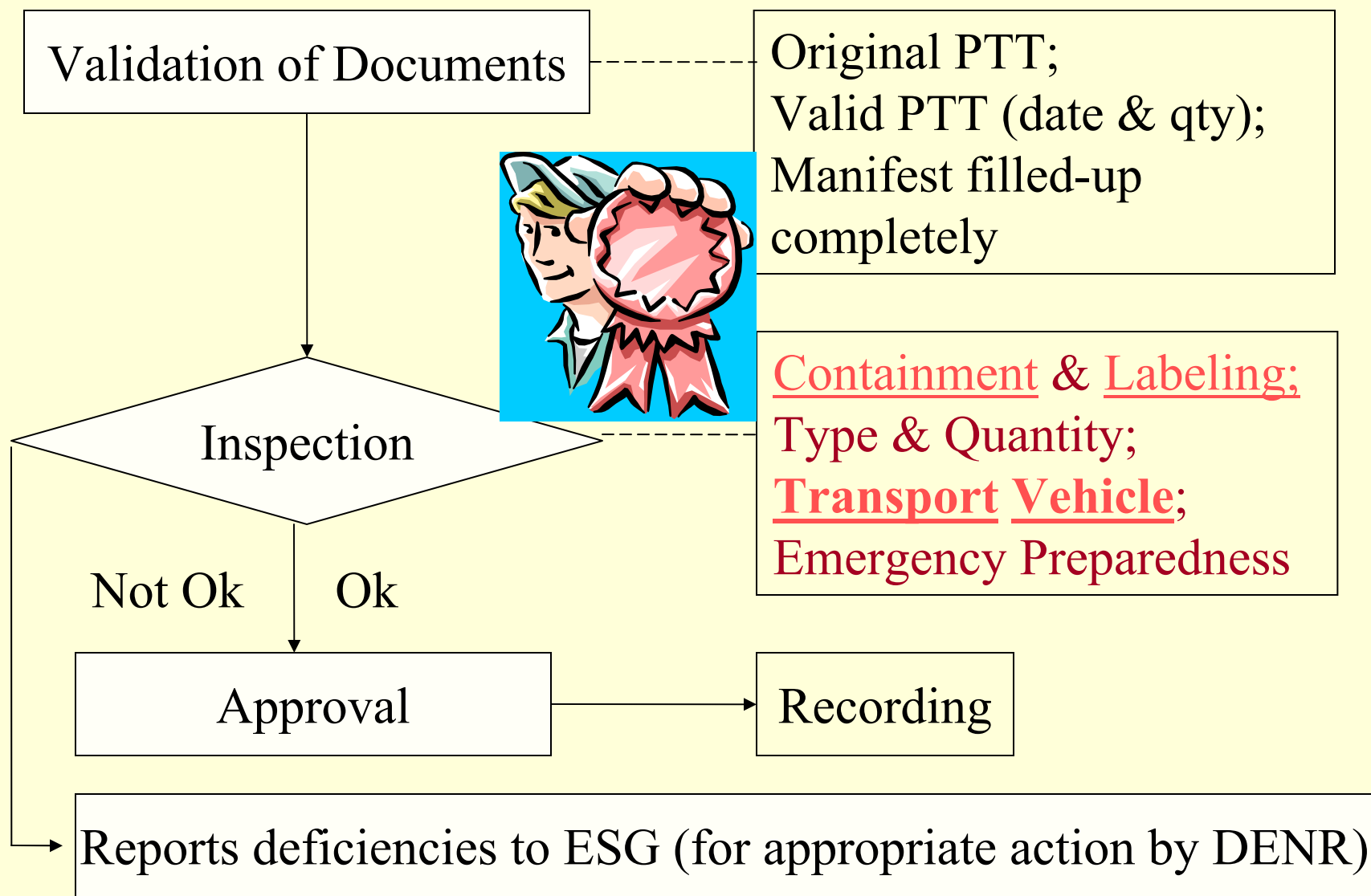

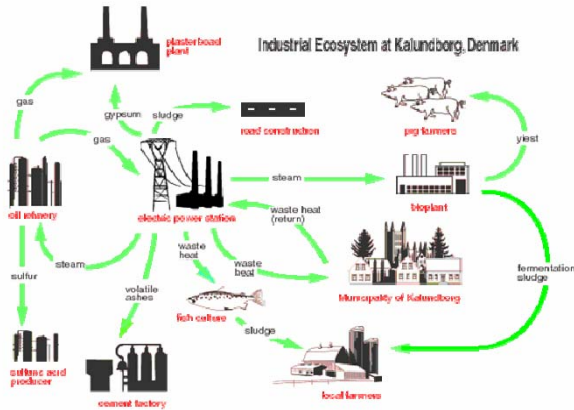
